1. Presentation by the Coachella Valley Volunteers in Medicine (CVVIM)

Director Hylton presented the staff report.

Loretta Moss, Community Liaison, introduced CVVIM as the only free clinic in the Coachella Valley. CVVIM serves the needs of primary care and dentistry patients from a state-of-the art, custom built clinic in Indio. CVVIM provides care to those who do not have health insurance and are not eligible for any government sponsored healthcare programs. The number of patients served by the clinic has grown steadily and by the end of 2013 reached over 500 patient visits per month. Average visits are 30% from Indio; 27% from Coachella; 8 or 9% from La Quinta; and 8 or 9% from Palm Desert.
