

**Report to La Quinta City Council  
Palm Springs International Airport Commission Meeting  
September 17, 2014**

**Action Items:**

The Palm Springs City Council approved the following actions:

1. Approved the hangar and apron lease for Signature Flight Support.
2. Ratified the re-appointment of Peter Freymuth as the Airport Commissioner to represent Riverside County.
3. Approved the contract with HNTB Corporation for environmental study phase of the airport Master Plan.

**Budget:** The unaudited financial report for the 2014 fiscal year showed excellent performance. Revenue was 100.1% of budget, while expenses were 91% of budget. Unrestricted cash at year-end was \$7.8 million – right on target.

**Passenger Activity:** Activity was up 9.4%, making 9 straight months of passenger growth.

**General:**

**Tower:** The old tower is now removed, and the new one is fully operational.

**Alaska Airlines:** Alaska has now implemented kiosks for self-check-in, and for baggage check.

**Starbucks:** The pre-security store is now operational.

The next meeting is scheduled for October 15, 2014.
