SUBJECT: UPDATE ON SEPTEMBER STORM REPAIRS

On October 2, 2014, O&J Golf Construction was issued a notice to proceed with emergency repairs to the Palmer Course at SilverRock Resort necessitated by the storm of September 8, 2014. The total estimated cost for this contract is \$816,830 which covers repairing all areas damaged by the storm including bunkers, tees, greens and golf cart paths. Staff anticipates that most, if not all, of this work will be covered by the City's insurance policy for the golf course. This work must be performed now in order for the golf course to reopen on November 3, 2014 as advertised. A ratification of this contract is scheduled for City Council approval on November 18, 2014.

On Friday, October 24, 2014, Granite Construction was issued a notice to proceed with emergency repairs to the bridge the City shares with Indian Wells on Highway 111 just west of the Cliffhouse restaurant. As explained at the City Council meeting of October 21, 2014 during the Public Works Department Report, the estimated cost is just over \$100,000 to repair the decking and abutments which were undermined by runoff from the highway and landscaping. The work will be performed on a time and material basis which staff anticipates will be covered by the City's insurance policy. A ratification of this work as well as any cost sharing recommendations with Indian Wells and Coachella Valley Water District is scheduled for City Council approval in December 2014.
