AUTHORIZATION TO REMOVE GRAFFITI FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY

In an effort to assist property owners, the City of La Quinta would like to extend to you a graffiti removal service, free of charge. The City has hired a private contractor to abate graffiti on commercial sites within twenty four (24) hours. In order to use this service, however, the City must have a 'Right of Entry" to gain access to your commercial property or Development to abate graffiti.

RIGHT OF ENTRY

The undersigned property owner authorizes the City of La Quinta to enter my private property between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. for the purposes of removing or covering graffiti with matching paint (to contractor's reasonable ability) from the premises. I understand that removal of the graffiti will be done at no cost to me. I understand that this consent form is valid from the date of signature.

Graffiti Abatement Services

The City of La Quinta has a program that extends graffiti abatement services to commercial properties. The City has entered into an agreement with a private contractor to provide commercial properties with FREE graffiti abatement.

If you have graffiti on your commercial property, we require a release form to allow the City access to your property. If you are leasing the property, we require that your property owner sign and return this form.
