When: March 28, June 13, or October 31, 2015

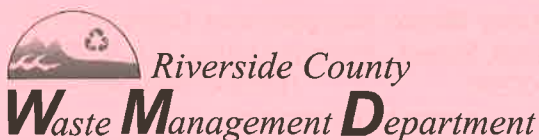

This class is available to Riverside County adult residents only.

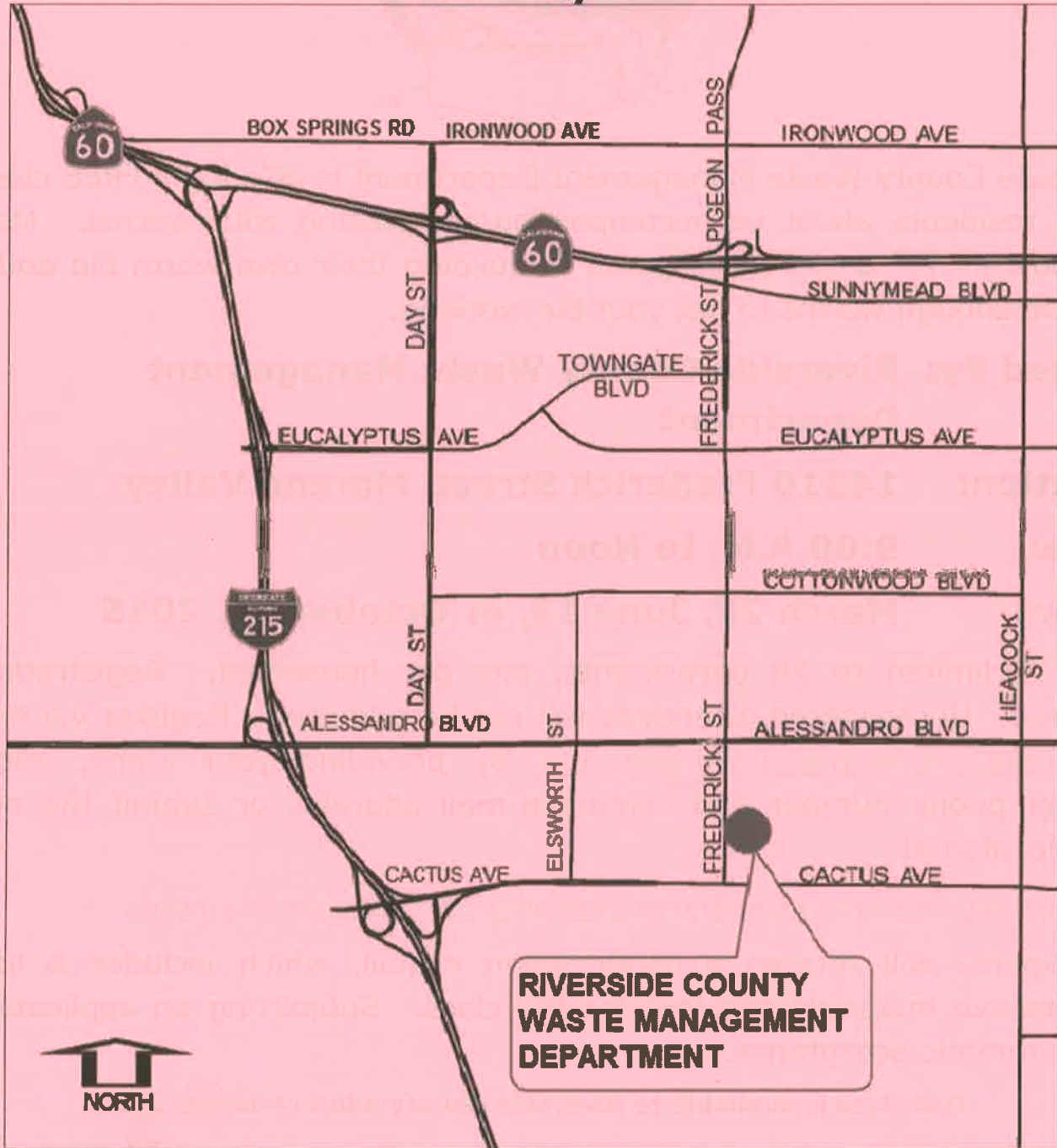
