STREET CLOSURE APPLICATIONS <u>MUST INCLUDE</u> SUCH INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR, IN ADDITION TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. A complete and accurate plot plan, drawn to scale, that shows the following:
 - a. Boundary and dimensions of property involved for Closure.
 - b. Location of intersecting or adjacent streets, drainage structures, and other features that may affect any aspect of the Closure.
 - c. Any proposed development, including planned buildings and structures, access, drainage, yards, drives, parking areas, landscaping, signs, and walls or fences, with dimensions.
- 2. A letter stating the nature and intent of the request, and an explanation as to how the proposed closure complies with California Vehicle Code Section 21101.
- 3. A completed Environmental Information Form, with the appropriate fee. This form can be found on the City of La Quinta website at www.la-quinta.org click on Government, then Planning Department, then Applications.
- 4. A legal description and plat prepared by a qualified registered professional, showing the full extent of the proposed closure.
